

In 2025 we convened a task force of dedicated members with a wide range of experiences and perspectives within JCP. Their work culminated in the launch of a three-year Strategic Plan, which has already set in motion many exciting initiatives: weekly Friday Evening Services that have welcomed record numbers to Shabbat; expanded Teen and Youth programming during the High Holy Days; the relaunch of Downtown Jews for young professionals; our first-ever Adult B'nai Mitzvah cohort and Men's Torah Study group; our Israel Engagement Series: Highlighting Healers and Hope; and continued growth in our Early Childhood Center and Hebrew School Project. The Strategic Plan also strengthens our foundation through improved communications, stronger marketing efforts, and thoughtful planning for JCP's long-term needs as our community continues to grow.

Thanks to your continued support and partnership, JCP is becoming the Center for Jewish Life in Lower Manhattan. We are poised for a bright and meaningful future, one in which we can welcome even more people seeking creative, joyful, and authentic Jewish experiences within a warm, inclusive, and engaged community.


